Centre For All Round Development (CARD) is an active and acclaimed NGO working in the field of education, vocational training, livelihood, disaster management, flood relief, sanitation and health, empowerment of women and the other marginalized groups in the society. At present organization is working in Samastipur and Arraria district of Bihar. It was established on the Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti Day of the Year 2002.

In this short span of activities, the CARD has gained the confidence of the various funding agencies such as UNICEF, Aide-et-Action, DFID, Action Aid association, Nomi Network, Heifer International and the State Government Departments.

CARD has adopted Participatory management involving various stake holders. Its 7 Members executive committee's regularly and actively monitors the functioning of the organization. Their expertise and experience of various fields help the organization in enhancing the quality of project implementation.

**In this year, CARD has implemented such programme which is mentioned below.**

### **Heifer International**

Bihar sustainable livelihood development (BSLD) projects aims to reduce living income gap of 4000 families through creating livelihood opportunity through livestock, Poultry/agriculture with a holistic approach. This project started at ground level from December 2020 and till now March 2021 we have formed 48 Original groups consist of 20 members each group. This project reaches its targeted community through Original and passes on groups, 1000 original group and 3000 pass on group. The concept of original and pass on groups is very interesting as it shows motivation of the community and also give them empowerment and space to explore in between the community and the kind of we fillings.

During this period of 4 months' time, we give our team members TOT SHG management, which will help them to build capacity and also helps to reach out the community and SHG. After capacitated the team we move forward to the community and provided SHG management training to 560 individual members through 28 SHG groups. This particular training builds capacity and confidence to the community member to carry forward group activity and rules, regulation and other. This training helps the community to build self-confidence and reduces dependency to manage their own group.

Heifer 12 cornerstone training is the main mandate of Heifer project. This training provides skills and capacity to the community to build confidence to stand in their own feet.



During this period, we provide technical support to 125 animals through 2 health camp in 2 different panchayats.

During this period, we open 39 accounts in 3 different national banks.

### **NOMI NETWORK:**

CARD is partner of NOMI NETWORK, an US based, international agency with the objective of Creating Economic Opportunity for poor and vulnerable women.

The objective of the project to act as a catalyst for bringing about social, economic and legal empowerment of girls and women belonging to the underprivileged sections of society through intervention in the areas like legal rights, economical initiative, skill building, micro-enterprises, entrepreneurship development and health.

In first phase 50 beneficiaries have been selected with the minimum educational qualification 10<sup>th</sup> pass and reading skill. Minimum age required 18<sup>th</sup> and above. 3 months session have been started with the beneficiaries to provide 80% life skill and 20% technical skill training.

The objective of life skill training is as under:

1. Basic hygiene
2. Time Management
3. Money management
4. Communication
5. Confidence building
6. Critical thinking skill
7. Team building
8. Problem solving

Technical skill trainings were based on these components:

1. Measuring
2. Basic stitching
3. Basic pattern
4. Basic business concept
5. Creative exercise

The organization has provided sector – specific technical skill that are marketable and needed in community. This phase was of three months. It is provided in the office premises through our staff trainer.

After successful completion of first phase the beneficiaries have chosen this type of trade for their next training.

1. Computer application
2. Cutting
3. Tailoring
4. Beautician

For the second phase training the trainees were associated to PMKVY and other agency of Govt. for their comprehensive knowledge and certificate.

In this period 2 batches consisting 100 beneficiaries have completed their training. In this period, we have provided employment to 30 beneficiaries in various sector. Our trained and committed volunteers have identified various employer partner and regular in touch with them.

The organization has also organized time to time special events during training period.

Which are as follows: -

### 1. Medical Health Camp

As we know health is precious for everyone. Therefore, in our **CARD** office till date we have organized health camp for 5 times. In this health camp our beneficiaries along with all staff got their checkup and awareness through renowned doctors of our area. Facilities which our beneficiaries and staff member have got in this camp are as follows:-

1. Measurement of B.P
2. Measurement of Weight Machine
3. Distribution of Medicine



### Flood Relief Distribution (August)

The flood submerged a huge land mass which put the victim families under the crisis to meet their basic needs as food, shelter and medical facilities. Therefore, Bihar, Forbesganj with the support

of Centre for All Round Development (CARD), distributed 30 kg Ration kit to the victim families so that they may get their meal. The 30 Kg ration kit includes flour, pulses, rice, spices, oil, soap, vegetables, sattu, soyabin, bucket, mat, and it was distributed to **more than 300 victim** families in the phase of relief work and the organization managed proper shelter and fresh drinking water for the victim families.

### Self Help Group

**Self-Help Group (SHG)** is a homogeneous **group** of poor women. This **group** is a voluntary one **formed** on areas of common interest so that they can think, organize and operate for their development. SHG function on the basis of co-operative principles and provide a forum for members to extent support to each other.

As we know saving is very important for everyone. Therefore our **CARD** organization has helped almost **60 beneficiaries** in opening of their account.

Not only that we have also practiced our beneficiaries for savings. We have created **4 SHG** groups. Each group is having **25 members** in which they are depositing **Rs 100** per months.

### **Action Aid Association:**

**Covid Relief work:** Due to Covid pandemic livelihood option had been collapsed within the marginalized community. Particularly, DNT caste were more affected during the period. The organization has identified DNT in two blocks I.e., Pusa and Kalyanpur of district Samastipur. DNT is completely movable but due to Covid their movement had disturbed completely. So, organization has decided to contribute some dry ration for their survival. 110 family were benefitted in this campaign. with the support Action aid association. Mask and dry ration have been distributed among the beneficiaries. More than 5000 mask were distributed within the community including sanitizer and soap.

**Dalit Adhikar Manch:** Dalit Adhikar Manch is a CBO's. Set – up of Manch is in every Panchayat. This CBO's is empowered of through various training, Legal awareness and promotion of leadership tool. It is federated at block and district level. The main aims and objective is to ensure access of all Govt. scheme. Focusing on MNREGA. To ensure



nondiscrimination in the area. Quarterly meeting has been conducted at block level and half yearly meeting at district level. Where they discuss about the challenges promotion of ward sabha is key area and creation of village development plan through mapping the vulnerability and resource.

**Mahila Adhikar Morcha:** In spite of the several scheme and Govt. initiative the women are still in back foot due to caste and patriarchy system. The effort of state Govt. is extremendous but still to do a lot.

To viewing this fact organization has built Panchayat level Mahila Adhikar Morcha and federated it up to block level.

A series of orientation programme has been conducted within intervening area. Thus, resulting the cases of domestic violence has been reduced. Gram Ketchahari has been strengthening through trainings and legal awareness. The cases have been filled in the Gram Kechahari. In case of need women move to Gram Ketchahari to register case. The women are aware to understand the circumstance of sexual harassment and sexual abuse. This Manch is functioning well. A strong network with the community has been seen. The Manch were in the lead role to ensure Covid vaccination within the community.

**Orientation of Adolescent:-** several orientation of programme has been conducted with adolescent.the impact of Covid can be seen easily on her face because all family was afraid. Maintain social distancing wearing of mask were core agenda for discussion. Prevention of child labour and child marriage were focus area for discussion. PM 15-point programme were also discussed in the orientation session.

**Enrollment Campaign-** Due to Covid panademic several migrated labour has return home with their family members. With the help of DAM and MAM enrollment drive has been conducted for migrated child in this respective location.



**Relief:** - Kalyanpur block is severe affected area during flood. Every year floods come and destroyed the house, crops, livestock etc. this year flood has also disturbed the area. Community was at high risk because of covid and flood. In this situation organization has decided to distribute



relief materials within the most vulnable community. 200 family has been identified who were at high risk. Then 200 family has given relief materials.

**Orientation on RTE and CFSS:** - volunteer training has been organized on RTE and CFSS. In this training 30 volunteers has been trained on RTE.
